## Facilitators Biography:

Joseph Kigunda, alongside Jennifer Kigunda, is co-founder and co-director of the Tania Centre, and has been educating and working with the deaf and Maasai communities in Kenya for 30 years. Joseph has worked with the Kenyan Ministry of Education to standardize Kenyan sign language and promote its use around the country. The Kigundas also helped establish the Karen Technical Training Institute for the Deaf, Kenya's first post-secondary school for deaf students.
